The National Park Service is responsible for protecting the natural state of the parks for the benefit of the public. To try to stop this, the National Paris Service announced in 1997, that people would only be able to visit some parks using public transport.

The oldest national park in the world is Yellowstone National Park, estab-lished in 1872. The largest US park is Wrangell-St Elias in Alaska with 13,000 square miles (34,000 square kilometers). It has few visitors because it is very remote. The most popular park is the Great Smoky Mountains. Many parks are well known for some special features, such as the Grand Canyon, the Ever-glades and the Petrified Forest.
