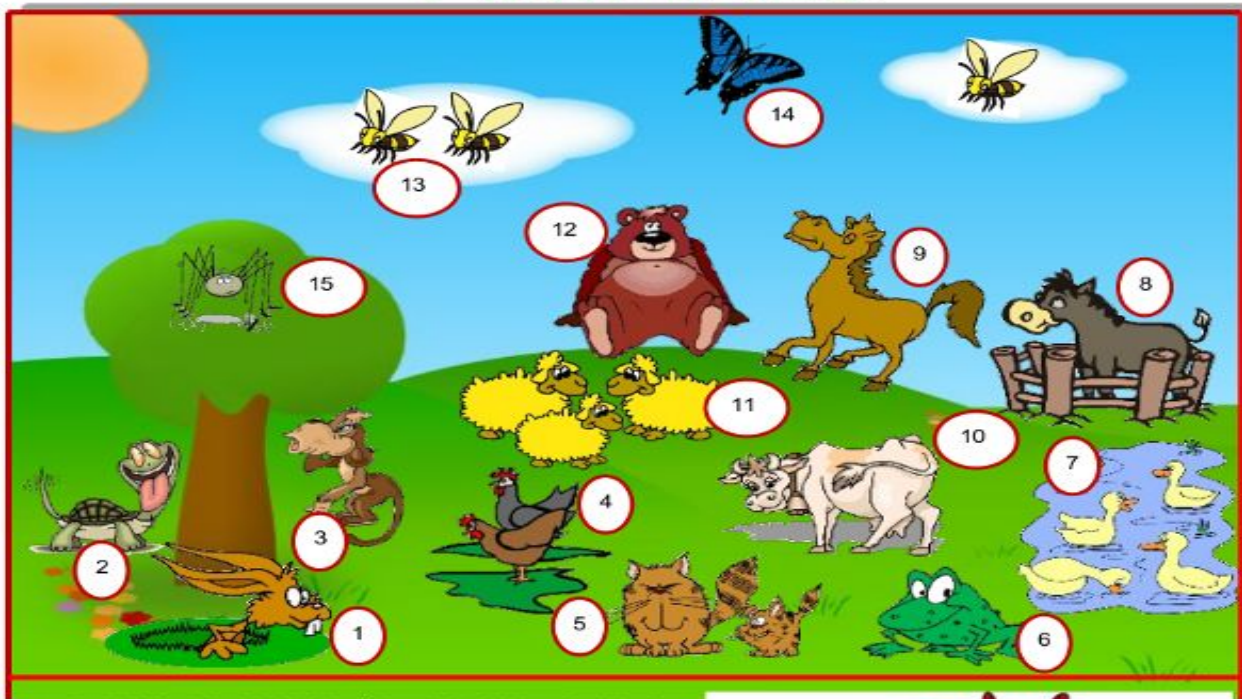


## Bài tập Tiếng Anh trẻ em: There is/ There are

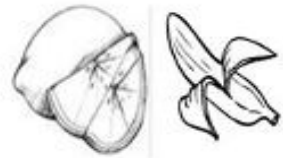

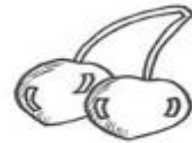
